USD 500 million is the estimated amount spent on fake diplomas each year 'Accredited Online Colleges'



Reported Fraud within the Education Industry



- A total of 13,969 fake education credentials were detected in Australia between 2012 and 2014 (CEF Monito, 2015)
- About 3,000 teachers in Bihar, India, have resigned for using fake degrees in 2015 (Times of India, 2015)
- The National Accountability Bureau (NAB) launched an inquiry against more than 600 teachers working in primary, middle and high schools for holding fake credentials (Dawn, 2015)






